





Our Post 16 Level 3 courses in music and art are open to students with private funding. We are experienced in supporting students with additional needs, and those who need a bit longer to achieve their educational goals.



We can offer placements of up to 14 hours per week for students who are thinking of working in the music or art industry, and who would be more suited to the vocational based RSL Level 3 qualifications than traditional music/art AS/A levels, or who require a top-up of UCAS points to get into university. We do not require evidence of prior attainment as a condition of acceptance, but any student who wishes to take up a placement should already be proficient as an artist, with a portfolio of work we can look at, or as a vocalist, instrumentalist, composer, producer, or writer (for those wanting to study music business). They should be committed to their studies and prepared to work independently at home in addition to the work completed when on-site. Subsidiary Diplomas can be completed in one year, and a full Diploma in two years. This might take longer if the student has additional needs or is not able to work independently.

Programmes are delivered mainly in small groups of up to 4, alongside students of a similar ability level. There will also be some 1-1 sessions and paired work. Performance opportunities are included in the package. We charge £3,750 per year (35 weeks) as a basic fee, which includes registration on the accredited pathway, but does not include the cost of any extra support needed.
